QUÉ ARE TÚ HACERING?

If the verb...	We have to...	Example
Ends in e	Eliminate the E and add -ING	Dance - Dancing
Ends in ee	We have to keep both E and we add -ING	See – Seeing
Ends in ie	Change the -ie for an -y and add -ING	Die – Dying
Ends in C/V/C	We double the last consonant and we add -ING	Run – Running
Doesn't follow any of the previous rules	We add – ING	Play - Playing

El presente continuo es la estructura que nos permitirá expresar acciones que están sucediendo en este mismo momento

+ Si queremos hacer una afirmación, usaremos la siguiente estructura:

Affirmative: Subject + Be + Verb(-ing) + complement

- Si, por el contrario, queremos hacer una negación, usaremos:

Negative: Subject + be + not + Verb(-ing) + Complement

? Por último, para crear una pregunta, usaremos:

Interrogative: be + Subject + Verb(-ing) + Complement

Affirmative	Negative	Interrogative
I am writing a letter	I am not writing a letter	Am I writing a letter?
You are writing a letter	You are not writing a letter	Are you writing a letter?
She is writing a letter	She is not writing a letter	Is she writing a letter?

AFFIRMATIVE

Subject	Be	Verb (-ing)	Complement
I	Am	Eating	A salad
You – we – they	Are	Eating	A salad
He – she – it	Is	Eating	A salad

Ya que la estructura del presente continuo lleva siempre BE, debemos aplicar siempre las formas Am, Are o Is.



Mr. Bastián is eating a salad

NEGATIVE

Subject	Be + not	Verb (-ing)	Complement
I	Am not	Eating	A salad
You – we – they	Are not	Eating	A salad
He – she – it	Is not	Eating	A salad

- Para la forma negativa, solamente agregamos Not después de la forma que usamos de Be.



Mr. Bastián is not eating a salad

INTERROGATIVE

Be	Subject	Verb (-ing)	Complement + ?
Am	I	Eating	A salad?
Are	You – we – they	Eating	A salad?
Is	He – she – it	Eating	A salad?

- Para formar preguntas, debemos cambiar de lugar el sujeto y el verbo be en la oración.
- Importante: No olvidar usar el signo de interrogación solamente al final de la pregunta.
